Thank you for volunteering to work on in the Kitchen at Korean Culture Camp this summer!

As a volunteer in the Kitchen, you will be preparing and serving lunch for all our campers and volunteers.

Because we must follow strict health codes in preparing these meals, please note our **Dress Code**:

- **Health regulations require everyone to wear head coverings** – baseball hats, scarves, or hairnets are all appropriate. **Bangs must be secure.**
- **SHOES MUST BE CLOSED-TOE.** Wear comfortable shoes, as you will be on your feet all day.

Some other “need to know” volunteer information:

- Please bring to camp: a cutting board and your favorite knife for cutting vegetables. If you wish, you may also bring a paring knife and kitchen shears.
- Come to the Kitchen Area in the morning after dropping off your camper. Plan to work until the camp day is over at 2:50, or until the kitchen is clean and the dishes are done.
- It is very important that you work the day(s) assigned to you. Camp needs volunteers for smooth operation. The Kitchen Staff is relying on you to fulfill your commitment to the schedule. If you must change your volunteer schedule, please contact the Kitchen Area Coordinators ASAP.
