We have secured an alternate location though, and thanks to the generous financial support we received from a number of families and individuals, the camper cost will only rise by \$5 per camper. Truly - thank you!

Cost: \$230 for Campers entering grades K - 7 (early bird discount of \$25 if registered by March 2)
\$30 for Teen Helpers entering grade 8 - graduated from high school (fee helps defray t-shirt and camp costs)

Who Needs to Register?

In order to get accurate counts for everyone who participates in camp, **EVERYONE must register!**

This includes:

- Campers
- Young Adult Volunteers
- Parent Volunteers
- Coordinators
- Teen Helpers

Registration Deadlines:

Online registration will close on Monday, April 30 at midnight for teens. Due to limited volunteer opportunities for teens, we recommend teens register as early as possible. Registration does not guarantee teens a volunteer spot at camp. Teen Coordinators will be in touch as teen volunteers are confirmed.

Online registration will close on Friday, June 1 at midnight for campers. We strongly recommend that you register by March 2 for planning purposes and the early-bird discount.

How do I make my payment?

Several online payment options are available and can be completed as part of your online registration process. For those who need a paper check option, an invoice can be printed and mailed along with a check made payable to Korean Culture Camp to the address printed on the invoice. Check payments should be made within 15 days of completing the online registration process.

Do you need me to volunteer this year?

Yes! The Korean Culture Camp Leadership Team is still working on figuring out the final logistics of this year's camp but we guarantee we will still need you to volunteer. There are no regularly paid staff for Korean Culture Camp which is how we keep our costs low. We depend on committed volunteers to help organize and run camp in July and we will need volunteers more than ever this summer.
